- contain latex or toxins (check labels carefully)
- have been stored or displayed for any length of time
- are nerf guns, swords, light sabers, knives or bows and arrows
- are religious, or specific to religious holidays

- From the 2420 circle drive, you'll enter the building to the south (on your left) to reach the Volunteer and In-Kind Giving office.

Step 3: Be Inspired!

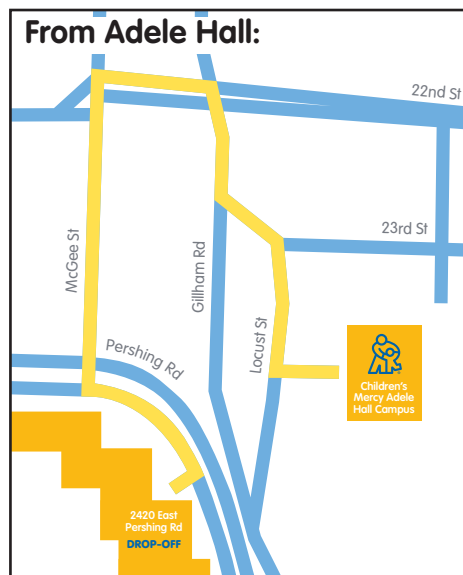
