Faculty Evening Networking Events provide an opportunity for faculty to engage with leadership and cultivate community among colleagues across diverse areas of academic medicine. These events are open only to faculty members and executive leadership.



OFD and OED Not-So-Journal Club series aims to cultivate conversations that inspire personal, and system change through examination of articles and other media that are particularly relevant to achieving equity in the health care environment.

Objectives include:

- Discuss among faculty, trainees, researchers, and health care professionals ways to improve equity in the health care environment.
- Discuss with a panel of leaders how to address systems and structures, confront implicit bias and racism and foster equity and inclusion in the workplace.
- Examine articles and personal feelings/behaviors in order to build a culture of inclusion.
- Identify solutions that can make Children's Mercy more equitable and inclusive.



FTDEIC Gender Equity Subcommittee Panel Discussion Series aims to foster faculty connections and support as we examine issues that are particularly relevant to the success and well-being of female faculty. Topics are selected from an intersectional framework, recognizing that multiple forms of inequity create overlapping disadvantage for individuals and groups.



Grant Writing Club was initiated to provide faculty dedicated time for intentional discussion of their research projects and funding pursuits. These semi-structured sessions will be facilitated by faculty experienced in grant writing, research design, and scholarship dissemination.
