

















ASTHMA MEDICINES

How to tell the difference between the quick reliever and controller

	QUICK RELIEVER	VS	CONTROLLER
EXAMPLES: <i>*More medicines on back page*</i>			
FAST OR SLOW	FAST  <p>Works in 10-20 minutes. Lasts up to 4 hours.</p>		SLOW  <p>May take a few weeks to work.</p>
WHEN TO USE IT	AS NEEDED <p>STOPS asthma symptoms. Use for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cough • Wheeze • Fast breathing 		DAILY <p>PREVENTS asthma symptoms when used everyday.</p> 
HOW IT WORKS	OUTSIDE  <p>Asthma Airway</p> <p>Relaxes muscles outside of airway.</p>		INSIDE  <p>Asthma Airway</p> <p>Controls swelling inside of airway. Keeps airway open.</p>

QUICK RELIEVER

Works fast. Use as needed to STOP asthma symptoms.
